n Evening of Friends, Wine & Art in Laguna Niguel on October 21, 2017 was a benefit for three of the cities charities- Laguna Niguel Historical Society, The American Legion Laguna Niguel Post 281 and The American Legion Auxiliary Laguna Niguel Unit 281. The event was a great success.

A highlight of the event was the "Artist in the Spot*light,*" Jeremy Romero 29, – whose work is selling

fast in San Diego and Orange County. Jeremv considers his

work mainly abstracted landscapes from desert to surf and his medium is acrylic. Striking pieces from past shows draw the viewer in with their own interpretations due to an emotional response to the often brilliant aqua, and pinks backing strong formations in complex geometric

designs. You can feel his love as a

surfer for California's unique vistas and ocean scenes. From the flat marsh land of Orlando, Florida, he came with his guitar to California to free his art and get closer to his obsession with mountains. Senator Pat Bates President. founder of the Laguna Niguel Historical Society, and founding


